Examples of Undergraduate Collaborative Learning & Teaching at Australian and International Universities

Higher Education Institution	Description
Australian Universities	In 2005, 19 of 38 universities offered campus-based collaborative learning opportunities particularly in undergraduate programs and rural clinical programs. These mainly focused on shared learning (indigenous studies, research methodologies etc) rather than specific IPE objectives (Thistlethwaite, 2007).
University of Tasmania Dept. of Rural Health Rural Clinical School	Shared Learning – <i>Perspectives on Ageing</i> Rural community based IPE – <i>RIPPER</i> program, piloted 2006 & 2007. Rural community placements
University of Sydney,	IP module on team work for all health science in first year. Pilot in 2006. IPE clinical placements since 2003 for final year healthcare students. IPL workshops on facilitation skills for clinical educators in 2007
University of Adelaide,	Shared learning in Anatomy. In 2007 curriculum review to reform & increase IPE (including placements) and OS staff development in IPL facilitation.

ACT Health, University of Canberra & Australian National University	Co-operating on IPE rural options for medical & allied health students
University of Western Australia	Rural clinical IPE focused on indigenous health and health promotion
<i>International Universities.</i>	Public policy has driven IPE especially in UK, Canada, USA, New Zealand and Europe
University of Otago, new Zealand	Generic first year in health sciences
University of Auckland, New Zealand	Shared learning across 12 degrees and IPE in Primary Health Care
University of Southampton & University of Portsmouth, UK	'New Generation Project' - 3 IPE units and clinical practice. Unit 1 in first year (introduces collaborative learning & team working), unit 2 in mid program (apply IPE team working & negotiation focused on audit of practice) & unit 3 in final year (IPE in health & social care services focused on service redesign)
University of West England, UK	3 IPE modules
Northumbria University, UK	Shared learning across 7 disciplines and practice based IPE (shadow team)
Kings College, London	Shared learning across 9 disciplines e.g. communications, healthcare ethics, infection control in year 1, IPE Practice (knowledge, skills & values) in Year 2 and IPE placements in final years
Universities of Sheffield & Sheffield Hallam (Combined Universities IPE Unit), UK	6 IPE modules across 9 disciplines from first to final years at Sheffield Hallam IPE in dentistry & its allied professions only at University of Sheffield Combined IPE clinical placements
Linkoping, Sweden	IPE orthopaedic ward in clinical school

University of Sherbrooke, Canada	Experiential IPE in clinical setting
Aga Khan University, Karachi, Pakistan	Experiential IPE in clinical setting
University of Washington, USA	Rural IPE placements
University of British Columbia, Canada	IPE teambuilding workshops IPE electives in program entitled 'Health Care Team Development' Pioneered fun IPE 'Health Care Team Challenge' competition adopted by UQ IPE Rural Placement program
University of Alberta, Canada	IPE Course IPE electives IPE indigenous & rural placement program
University of Toronto, Canada	'Pain Week' – students from 6 disciplines in 'shared classes' and small group IPE simulation exercises on pain management
Memorial University of Newfoundland, Canada	IPE Course
Northern Ontario Medical School & University of Saskatchewan, Canada	IPE programs with integrated clinical placements
