### **Assessment and Academic Progress Review**

*In the Faculty of Health Science*, with due regard to University Rule 111 Academic Assessment, as delegates of the Dean and Associate Dean (Teaching & Learning), Heads of Schools or their Deputies will chair meetings of assessment committees.

At the beginning of each academic year, the Faculty Executive Officer will confirm these delegations in writing for Student and Academic Services.

At the end of each semester, after meetings of School assessment committees, the Chairs will meet with the Associate Dean (T&L) who will formally approve all results and APR decisions.

Subsequent to formal approval by the Associate Dean (T&L), any further advice on results and changes to results will be provided by Heads of Schools and their Deputies to the FHS Executive Officer for the Associate Dean's approval and forwarding to the Examinations Office.

### **Credit**

*In the Faculty of Health Science*, with due regard to University Rule 112 Admission and Student Progress, each School will have a credit policy which is readily accessible by students.

In particular, each School will include in that credit policy details of credit arrangements for students in transnational programs.

Each School will explore the feasibility of maintaining an on-line credit entry database accessible by staff and students in the Faculty and with the ability to be uploaded to the Unified Student Record System (USRS).
